STAGA HOUSE WRAPPING

When you build or restore a house, it is important to protect it against rain. This can be done by using a temporary protection, for example a tarp which will then be removed when the building is ready to withstand rain.

You can also use a house wrapping that is attached to the outside of the studs where the product prevents the studs from being exposed to rain until the outer façade are attached. The wrapping also reduces the heat radiation the house generates, due to the fact that it prevents the wind from coming in contact with the insulation and thus avoids unnecessary air movement in the insulation.

RADON MEMBRANES

Allowable target and limit values for radon in residential buildings are continually tightened every year for the purpose of ensuring our health, which we of course think is good. There is talk now about reducing the permitted limit from 200 to 100 Becquerel. In practice, this means that if your house does not meet the limit values you risk getting sick and it will also lower the resale value of your house or apartment.

Staga has developed two different types of radon protection systems. The first one, Staga Radon Wallcovering, is used to stop radon in existing houses that are built completely or partially of blue concrete and the product works as ordinary wallpaper you apply to the wall that effectively shuts out radon. The second, Staga Radon Groundcover, is a product that you dig into the ground on which the house stands and it stops the radon from seeping up into the house. This can be done either while building or later if your house rests on a Croft cross round.

STAGA VAPOUR BARRIER

A vapour barrier prevents moisture, in the form of water vapour, from inside the building to escape in the construction which causes problems with moisture and mould. A vapour barrier is a damp-proof foil which is placed on the inside of the wall. The vapour barrier is of great importance for the protection against moisture. The quality of both materials and installation is important since the vapour barrier needs to work throughout the lifespan of the building.

FLOOR PAPER

There are a lot of different types of materials that are designed to protect your flooring at restoration and repainting. The main differences are if the fibres which the paper or carton is made of is being used for the first time (virgin fibre) or if they are recycled fibres (recycled fibres). A carbon paper based floor protection is usually more durable and stronger and is therefore used in more demanding renovations whilst recycled product does not have the same requirements.

Cardboard floor protection

This is a solid, waterproof cardboard made only with virgin fibre. It is used for temporary protection of all types of floors, for example wood, plastic and textile flooring. It is also available with plastic coated surface.

Floor protection and Floor protection+

This is a temporary protection of floors and decor for painting work. Its advantage is the absorbing surface that absorbs the paint faster than other materials as well as to the flexibility of the material makes it easier to use for stairs etc. Can and should be re-used multiple times. This product is based on NW materials.

Stuff-based paper

These are footfall dampening separation layers for dry and vapour proof floor constructions, for example hardwood floors. This product has the quality of natural fibre, produced on a mixture of cellulose and textile fibre.
